 - **Subject to Change** - All requirements and policies are subject to change without notice. The course list is updated regularly. Please check with your advisor to verify that a course fulfills any given requirement.

- **Using Other Coursework** - Some courses from other departments or institutions may fulfill degree requirements, but often require a petition. Please check with your academic advisor.
-
- **Total Credits** - You must have at least 180 college-level credits to earn this degree.
 - **Transfer Credits** - The University of Washington Bothell allows 135 credits to transfer. Of those, up to 90 credits may be lower division courses (100-200 level). You may petition to have more lower division credits transfer.
 - **Cross-Campus Enrollment** - After earning a certain number of credits at UW Bothell (usually 15), students may take up to 15 of their credits per academic year at other UW campuses.
 - **Senior Residency** - To earn a degree from The University of Washington, students must complete 45 of their final 60 credits at their home campus (UW Bothell is your home campus).
 - **Minimum GPA** - All degree-specific requirements must be completed with a grade of 2.0 or higher. In addition, you must maintain a GPA of 2.0 to earn a degree from UW Bothell.
